

In accordance with the jury verdict rendered on January 29, 2016, the Court
issues the following Judgment:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there be
judgment herein in favor of the plaintiff, Darleen Levy, and against the defendants,
Jessica A. Lewis, Steakhouse New Orleans, LLC, and Maryland Casualty
Company, jointly, severally, and *in solido*, for \$30,000 for physical pain and

suffering, past, present and future; \$10,000 for mental anguish and suffering, past, present and future; \$7,500 for loss of life's enjoyment, past, present and future; and medical expenses of \$14,000, together with legal interest thereon from the date of judicial demand until paid, at the costs of defendants, Jessica A. Lewis, Steakhouse New Orleans, LLC and Maryland Casualty Company.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there be judgment herein in favor of defendants, Progressive Security Insurance Company and Great Northern Insurance Company, and against plaintiff, Darleen Levy, dismissing all claims of Darleen Levy, with prejudice, at plaintiff's cost.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there be judgment herein in favor of defendants, Jessica A. Lewis, Steakhouse New Orleans, LLC, Maryland Casualty Company, Progressive Security Insurance Company and Greater Northern Insurance Company and against plaintiff, Darleen M. Jacobs, A Professional Law Corporation, dismissing all claims of plaintiff, Darleen M. Jacobs, a Professional Law Corporation, with prejudice, at plaintiff's cost.
